

Class Descriptions

All classes will hold a final performance on the last day of class

Act A Story – Bring in your favorite story and using props, costumes and acting techniques the class will bring it alive on stage. The students will then find creative ways to tie all the stories together.

Comedy, Improv, Acting – Create a memorable acting character, hone your comedy chops, and get more roles with your ability to do comedy. Learn how to construct and tell a joke. Become a better actor and feel confident when auditioning.

Creative Dramatics – Theatre games, improvisation, scene development, the children will be having so much fun they won't even notice they are learning acting techniques, characterization and ensemble work.

Let's Make a Movie – Learn the techniques involved in making a movie both in front of and behind the camera. Write, direct, act, and shoot the various scenes.

Do A Play All the Way (the following 3 listings) – Be part of an amazing collaboration. Students spend part of the day in drama tackling acting, part of the day with the Dance Project learning dance and part of the day with the Center for Visual Artists working on sets and costumes:

Jungle Book – Adapted from Disney's beloved animated film and the works of Rudyard Kipling, the "man cub" Mowgli bounds through the jungle and learns what it means to be human. Join the host of colorful characters and sing your favorite songs from the movie.

Willy Wonka – The delicious adventures experienced by Charlie Bucket on his visit to Willy Wonka's mysterious chocolate factory light up the stage in this captivating adaptation of Roald Dahl's fantastical tale. Featuring lots of fun songs, the show is guaranteed to delight everyone's sweet tooth.

Treasure Island (non-musical, with Center for Visual Artists only) Har, har Maties. Join the swashbuckling pirate band of Long John Silver and his gang as they search for buried treasure. Acting, Stage Combat, set building and design.
