CLUB AND CLASS LOCATION



Discover the fun and excitement as you convert wind power to sail power!

From boat rigging to knot tying, learn the skills of sailing. Determine wind direction and sail position, then head out on the water to practice sailing a course in an Aqua Finn, Laser Pico, Capri 14.2, Tanzer 16, Wayfarer, Lightning or Flying Scot under the guidance of our expert instructors.

Intermediate classes require basic sailing skills and will teach the sailor advanced skills, including an introduction to racing.

Minimum age is 16 for adult classes.

NOTE for Junior Sailors:

Passing a swim test is a requirement of all junior sailors. They shall bring the completed swim test form to the first class. Certification can be done at the Greensboro Aquatic Center for a nominal fee or by a Certified Life Guard. The official form can be obtained from the Lake Townsend Yacht Club website:

The swim test consists of swimming 50 yards using an approved stroke, floating for two minutes, and putting on a personal flotation device (pfd) while in the water.
