Forms

Medical forms must be turned in before you can leave your child. They are located on our website or you can call to get a copy faxed or mailed.

Medication

Any medication should be given DIRECTLY to a counselor with a Medicine Administration Form.

Sign In and Out

All campers must be signed in and out everyday. A picture ID is required to pick up the camper. If a family member is picking up your camper, please make sure their name is on the list and they know to bring an ID. Campers may be dropped off no earlier than 7:30 a.m. and must be picked up no later than 5:45 p.m. There is a \$10 late fee for every 15 minutes that you are late picking up your child.

Toys/ Games

Please do not send toys of value to camp. This includes video games and mp3/cd players.

Lunch and Snacks

Please send a bag lunch, labeled with your camper's name. Please do not send any food that requires complicated mixing or microwaving procedures. We do not mind warming things up, but foods like microwavable macaroni and cheese mixes are not permitted due to the inordinate amount of time required to prepare these dishes. We provide 2 snacks a day. Campers are allowed to purchase snacks and drinks at the vending machines.

Sunscreen

Sunscreen should be labeled and given to the counselors. If you want us to apply sunscreen PLEASE make sure to give it to the counselor because often the campers will forget. We do suggest the spray on sunscreen due to ease of use.

Dress Code

We have many activities and crafts planned for this school year so campers are encouraged to dress in such a way that they can participate in all we have to offer. This includes shoes. Outdoor activities are a regular part of the camp schedule, so please provide coats and hats during the cold months. **TENNIS SHOES ARE MANDATORY!**

It is important to us at Bur-Mil that there is open communication between the camp and the camper families.
