***EDGEWORTH AREA STREET LANE/STREET CLOSINGS TO
BEGIN MONDAY, AUGUST 7TH***

Friday, August 4, 2006 – The City of Greensboro announces intermittent lane closings on Edgeworth Street between Smith and Battleground beginning Monday, August 7th at 9:00 a.m. The closings are due to storm sewer relocation work in the area. There will also be intermittent lane closings on Smith Street between Edgeworth and Eugene during the same time period.

Also beginning Wednesday, August 9th at 9:00am, Edgeworth Street will be closed in its entirety between Smith and Battleground for about one week. Motorists are asked to follow the signed detour route beginning eastbound on Smith Street, left on Eugene and left on Battleground. The affected roadways are expected to be open for normal use within six to eight weeks.
