***WEST MARKET STREET AND WEST GREENWAY DRIVE TO CLOSE BEGINNING TODAY***

**GREENSBORO, NC (July 17, 2006)** – The City of Greensboro Water Resources Department announces the immediate closing of West Market Street to through traffic between West Market Street and West Greenway Drive. Crews will begin work on a sewer main replacement and relocation project. The closure will begin Monday, July 17 and will remain closed until Friday, July 21.

Local traffic and emergency service vehicles will be able to access the established detour during the closure. The detour will take motorists north on East Greenway Drive, west on Madison Avenue, and south on West Greenway Drive back to West Market Street. Motorists are advised to use caution, follow posted detour routes and slow down when approaching the work area. For more information, call 373-4632.
