DESCRIPTION: The Greensboro Playwrights’ Forum and 3rd Stage Theatre Co. are proud to announce the 15th Annual North Carolina New Play Project: *Twelve Treatises on Memory, An Epistemological Slapstick* (with Sock Puppets) by Asheville playwright John Crutchfield. The Storyline:

Twelve Treatises on Memory is a story about two former lovers, who meet again after many years apart. While one has, at first glance, succeeded in “moving on,” the other seems more unsettled; unable to come to terms with his past. He makes contact with his first love, seeking resolution and confirmation as to exactly what happened between them and why. Seeing each other again has some surprising consequences, including a lot of (sometimes very funny) questions about the nature and truth of memory.
