RE: Native American Cultural School Days (November 5-6, 2009)

In honor of the declaration of November as Indian Heritage Month and the commitment to continue educating our community about the Native American culture, we are pleased to invite you to participate in the 8th Annual Native American Cultural School Days. **The Native American School Days will be held on Thursday and Friday, November 5 & 6 (2009) for grades Pre K-5 only. Session times are listed on the registration form.** We hope you will make plans to join us for this exciting event. The festival will take place at the Greensboro Cultural Center. All registered schools / classes will be assigned to groups with a set schedule of activities. Upon receipt of your registration form, we will forward your confirmation letter. Listed below is pertinent information regarding the Native American Cultural School Days.

Admission: The admission is \$ 5.00 per student. There is no admission charge for teachers and teacher assistants. For parent volunteers, you are allowed one per every 10 students at no charge. Additional parent volunteers must pay \$3.00 each. This fees includes admission, a performance featuring native dance and drumming, a hands-on craft session including supplies, and a legend (storytelling) session.

Registration /Payment: Registration is accepted on a first come - first serve basis. Fax your registration form immediately (prior to payment) to 336.373.2659, City Arts, Attn: Deborah Scales. City Arts Offices are located at 200 North Davie Street, Greensboro, NC 27401. **Payment must be received by/on Friday, October 30, 2009.** Checks are made payable to the **Guilford Native American Association.**

Schedule: On your registration form, please indicate your 1st and 2nd session choice. Upon receipt of your registration form, you will receive a session confirmation.

Traders: Traders will be set up to sell items (\$1-\$3). This is optional for students, teachers and parents.

Transportation: Make your bus reservations immediately.

Parking: Directions, drop-off / pick-up instructions and parking information will be forwarded approximately one week prior to the event.

Safety Considerations: As to provide a safe environment for students, teachers and volunteers, the Greensboro Fire Department's Fire Inspection Bureau has done a thorough walk-through of all event areas and have deemed the facility and event set-up within regulated guidelines. **In addition, pre-registration is required for all students, teachers and parent volunteers. Your registration numbers must be as accurate as possible.**
