NC A&T STATE UNIVERSITY HOMECOMING will be celebrated on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, October 10 - 12, 2008. As NC A&T welcomes alumni, students and friends to the area for the 2008 homecoming celebration, your neighborhood may encounter higher traffic, pedestrian volume and parking concerns. The City of Greensboro Police Department, GDOT, GTA and other departments are working closely with the University and Homecoming Committee to manage events that place a premium on a safe and enjoyable weekend. Activities include:

HOMECOMING SCHEDULE:

NEW AGGIE FANFEST (formerly A&T Pavilion) will be held in the parking lot of War Memorial Stadium at the corner of Lindsay and Yanceyville Streets. Traditional vendors selling unique food, beverages, t-shirts, hand-bags and other apparel will be open for business on the following days and times. A new schedule features "extended" Saturday hours and Sunday has been added:

AGGIE FANFEST is a new name and new brand for this special vendor event.

◆	Saturday, October 11	7:00 am to 11:59 pm
◆	Sunday, October 12	11:00 am to 5:00 pm



For the first time, several Carnival type rides will be provided for families with children. Carnival rides will be operated:

◆	Friday, October 10	4:00 pm to 9:00 pm
◆	Saturday, October 11	Noon to 9:00 pm
◆	Sunday, October 12	Noon to 5:00 pm

KICK-OFF BLOCK PARTY will kick-off on Friday afternoon, October 10 with a Block Party featuring the World's Greatest Entertainer, Doug E. Fresh, performing at the Greatest Homecoming on Earth. The Block Party is scheduled from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm. Additional Homecoming events continue at the Coliseum Complex on Friday night including the NC A&T SGA Step Show and the NC A&T Alumni Concert featuring Charlie Wilson of the Gap Band and En Vogue.

HOMECOMING PARADE: The Homecoming parade route will affect street closings starting at 5:30 am on Saturday, October 11 including Murrow Blvd. from Lee Street to E. Lindsay and E. Lindsay from Murrow Blvd. to Aggie Stadium.

FOOTBALL GAME – NC A&T plays Morgan State for homecoming on Saturday, October 11 at 1:30 pm in Aggie Stadium.

NEIGHBORHOOD AREA: The following streets will be closed beginning 5:30am Saturday to allow for the parade route and other Homecoming activities:

- ◆ Sullivan Street from Park Avenue to E. Lindsay Street
- ◆ Boyd Street south of Dewey Street to E. Lindsay Street
- ◆ Yanceyville Street south of Homeland Avenue to E. Lindsay Street
- ◆ Lindsay Street from E. Bessemer Avenue to Yanceyville Street

SHUTTLE BUS SERVICE: University chartered shuttle buses will run from 7:00 am to 6:30 pm on Saturday, October 11. Shuttles will travel from the Sheraton Hotel on High Point Road, The Depot, Church Street and Davie Street parking decks. During the entire day, shuttles will run north on Summit Avenue to Sullivan Street to E. Lindsay Street. The shuttles will unload guests at the gates to Aggie Stadium and then exit the area via Headquarters Drive to Highway 29 or at E. Bessemer Avenue back to Summit Avenue. *Note that Yanceyville Street will be barricaded at Summit Avenue, but not closed to local traffic.* Illegally or improperly parked vehicles may be towed from the area during this time. *You may still enter and exit the neighborhood using Circle Drive, Dewey Street, Castlewood Drive, Homeland Avenue, Boyd Street, Park Avenue, and Palmetto Street.* Please refer to the map on the reverse side.

At the conclusion of the game, buses will be parked along Lindsay Street facing Headquarters Drive and E. Bessemer Avenue. Passengers may walk or ride from the stadium to the vending or bus area.

THE GREENSBORO FARMER'S CURB MARKET will be relocated to the Greensboro Coliseum Pavilion for a special one day Farmers Market Fall Harvest Festival. Admission and parking are free at the Coliseum on the morning of Saturday, October 11. The parking spaces at the Curb Market will be open for short term 30 minute per vehicle parking on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

ENTREPRENURIAL PARKING: If you charge a fee for parking on your property or perform any other business activities, you must obtain a Privilege License from the City of Greensboro.
