From Business Interstate 85/40, take the Elm/Eugene Exit. Travel north on Elm/Eugene you reach Downtown area. Elm/Eugene will become Eugene Street. Continue north on Eugene Street to Washington St. Governmental Plaza is on Greene St near the intersection of Washington and Greene Streets

Free parking is available on both corners of Eugene/Washington.

Each participant will be required to wear a race number on the front of his/her shirt. Time Splits will be called at each mile point.
