

Meeting Sought By Negroes

WINSTON-SALEM, Feb. 13 (AP) — Leaders of the Negro lunch counter protest here will ask Mayor Marshall Kurfess to organize and mediate a meeting between them and chain-store managers in an attempt to resolve the week-long, anti-segregation movement.

Carl Matthews, executive chairman of the Winston-Salem protest against segregated chain-store lunch counters, said Saturday a five-man committee will seek an appointment with the mayor "sometime this week."
