

SERVICE IS REFUSED; NEGROES LEAVE STORE

SALISBURY, Feb. 16 (AP)—Three Negro men sat down at the lunch counter in the F. W. Woolworth Co. store here today but left when they were refused service.

Store officials said the men, dressed in clerical garb including the traditional white clerical collars, remained in the store about 10 minutes before departing.

The incident occurred only a few days after a committee of students of Livingstone College here indicated that no sitdown was being considered.
