

Counter Service Is Resumed At Durham

DURHAM, Feb. 25 (AP)—Lunch counter service was resumed on a segregated basis today at Kress and Woolworth stores here, with only a brief carry-over of the demonstrations by Negro students that led to the closing of the counters on Feb. 8.

Service at the counters was discontinued in "the interest of public safety" after Negro students staged sitdown demonstrations in the stores.

The only incident today came in late afternoon. Three young Negro men, believed to be students at North Carolina College, walked into Woolworth's around 3:20 p.m. and took seats at the counter. They left a short while later after being refused service.
