

## WHITE YOUTH FINED FOR CURSING NEGRO

DURHAM, March 1 (UPI)—A white youth was fined \$10 and court costs today for cursing Negro pickets marching in front of a variety store which refused to serve them at its lunch counter.

—Another white defendant, a 17-year-old girl, was cleared in Durham Recorder's Court of assault and battery against a Negro picket.

Judge A. R. Wilson fined Ronnie Dale Broadwell, 18, of Chapel Hill, after convicting him of disorderly conduct.

Charges against Linda Teston of Durham were dropped after she asked her Negro accuser how he could identify her as the member of a crowd which spat popcorn at him Monday. She also told Judge Wilson she could not "spit that far."

At Monroe, 10 Negro high school students staged demonstrations which forced two drug store managers to close their lunch counters.
