

LABOR LEADER URGES DEMONSTRATION SUPPORT

ATLANTIC CITY, N.J., March 26 (AP) — Organized labor should support Southern Negroes in their fight for racial equality, veteran labor leader David Dubinsky said tonight.

Sympathy with Negroes who are staging demonstrations in the South is not enough, said Dubinsky in a speech prepared for the silver jubilee convention banquet of the Jewish Labor Committee.

Dubinsky is the president of the International Ladies' Garment Workers Union.
