

Man Is Charged With Trespass

A Negro man was charged with forcible trespass yesterday afternoon following an incident at the Greensboro Country Club during which the club manager's wife said he made an obscene remark to her.

Clyde Frederick Craig, 22, of 412 N. Beech St., who told police he was a music student at A&T College, was jailed on the trespass charge.

Mrs. H. B. McLean said Craig pushed past her into the club house after she told him she did not have any work for him to do.

While he was inside the club building, Mrs. McLean said Craig made an obscene remark to her, then walked out the door.

Her husband was attracted by her screams and followed the Negro in his car while Mrs. McLean reported the incident to police. Craig walked west from the club on Sunset Drive and was stopped by officers at the intersection of Cleburne Street.

Police said he admitted making the remark to Mrs. McLean and said he did it because she told him she did not have any work for him.
