

TWO NEGRO STUDENTS FREED OF CHARGES

DURHAM, March 28 (AP)—Judge A. R. Wilson in recorder's court today quashed trespass charges against two Negro students in connection with their insistence on eating on the premises sandwiches brought Friday at Tanner's downtown fruit drink and sandwich shop.

He held the warrants charged John Wilson Edwards, 18, and Mathew Donovan Phillips, 19, with going on the firm's property against the wishes of the operators, but the evidence showed they already had been served when they refused to leave and insisted on eating the sandwiches on the premises.
