

# High Point Stores Are Asked To Try Integration Plan

HIGH POINT, March 30 (AP)—The High Point Human Relations Committee today made public a recommendation that integrated lunch counter service be tried in variety stores here for 60 days.

Mayor Jesse Washburn and two committee members have been named to notify the store managers of the recommendation.

Whether the recommendation will take effect depends on the reaction of the stores. The human relations committee has no power to enforce its recommendations.

The committee was appointed in February after Negro sitdown demonstrations erupted into violence here.
