

Trespass Cases Postponed Here

Trial for 43 Negro and two white students charged with trespassing at the S. H. Kress Co. downtown store has been continued until May 10 in Municipal-County Court.

Solicitor William Vaden said the trials were continued at the request of defense counsel. The trials had been set for tomorrow.

The 45 students were arrested last Thursday at the store after management asked them to leave the lunch counter.

The group was protesting the segregated lunch counter service at the store.
