

# Sit-In Cases Are Postponed

Trespassing cases against 45 Negro college students arrested last Thursday at a downtown lunch counter were continued yesterday to May 11 in Municipal County Court.

Solicitor William Vaden requested the continuance of Judge Hampton Howerton Jr., senior judge, at the petition of defense attorneys.

The group, composed of 43 Negro and two white students, was protesting segregated lunch counter service at the S. H. Kress Co. store in the 200 block of South Elm Street.
