

# Danville To Vote On Library

DANVILLE, Va., May 12—Danville voters early in June will vote on a proposal bearing on whether the public library shall be integrated or closed.

The City Council approved the charter of the referendum today. The people will choose between closing the library system; closing the system if private library facilities are deemed available; open the library to white and colored alike; permit the council to work out a modified library service by accepting request for reference works and send them out and close the library building and dispense books by bookmobile.

The vote on the referendum was 6 to 3. Judge Aiken, by law, must fix the referendum date with 20 days notice to the voters.
