

New Warrants Served On 45

New warrants were served yesterday on 45 A&T and Bennett College students charged with trespassing at a downtown lunch counter and trial for the group has been reset for May 27 in Municipal-County Court.

The new warrants were issued yesterday when defense attorneys for the students pointed out technical errors on the original warrants. The court declared no prosecution on the original warrants.

The students, which include two white girls and 43 Negro boys and girls, are accused of trespassing at the S. H. Kress & Co. store, 208 S. Elm St., April 21.
