

Integration Slow, Minister Says

A white minister of an integrated Chapel Hill church told Negroes at a National Association for the Advancement of Colored People meeting last night that "integration is moving too slowly."

The Rev. Charles Jones, pastor of the Chapel Hill Community Church, spoke at the final meeting of the fiscal year of the Greensboro chapter of the NAACP at St. Stephen's Christian Church.

The Rev. Mr. Jones, a member of the "Sit-Down" Advisory Committee in Chapel Hill, told the audience of his experiences since he was named to the committee three months ago.

He told the group that they are giving away their self-respect when they go into stores being picketed. He also urged them to vote in the coming elections and to support the NAACP.
