

Negro Pressmen Honor City Student

A Greensboro youth was honored Saturday by the Capital Press Club of Washington.

The organization of Washington Negro newspapermen presented Ezell Blair Jr., a freshman at A&T College and one of the initiators of the sit-in movement, its civil rights award at the 17th annual Awards Dinner held at the Hotel Willard on Saturday night.

The citation read, in part for, "awakening the consciousness of America to the realization that today's legion of proud, beautiful and splendid youth will accept nothing less than the dignity of full, first class citizenship."
