

Grand Jury Will Consider 'Sit-Down' Cases Monday

Bills of indictment charging 43 Negro students and two white girls with trespassing at S. H. Kress & Co. here April 21 will be considered by the Guilford Grand Jury next Monday.

The grand jury will meet in connection with the opening of a two-week criminal term of Guilford Superior Court.

The mass arrest of the students was made in connection with the sit-in demonstrations begun here in February at two downtown variety stores. In Municipal-County Court hearings the 45 requested jury trials of their cases.

Also to be considered Monday is a manslaughter bill against

Walter Daniel Jackson, 23, of Burlington, charged in connection with the death of Shirley Williams in an auto accident on Highway 220 South about 6 miles south of Greensboro. The jury will also consider a bill charging Frank Geater, 35, of Route 1, Julian, of hit and run driving Feb. 27 in connection with an accident on Alamance Church Road in which Hubert A. Smith was injured.

A bill of indictment will be presented also against Marion Garrett, 21, of High Point, charging felonious assault on Martin Lee with a steak fork last May 1.

The grand jury will consider a number of other bills during its session Monday.
