

Sitdown Cases To Be Heard

Forty-three Negro and two white students will have their cases considered by the Guilford Superior Court grand jury Monday. They are charged with trespassing on the premises of S. H. Kress & Co.

The arrests were made in connection with the sitdown demonstrations which began here at two variety stores. Attorneys for the 45 students requested jury trials.

A number of other bills are expected to be considered by the Grand Jury.
