

Trespass Cases Set For Trial

The trespass cases against 43 Negro students and two white students of A&T and Bennett Colleges are to be heard during a special criminal term of Guilford Superior Court the week of Aug. 8, Solicitor Horace R. Kornegay said yesterday.

He said he has not been notified as to which judge will conduct the one-week term.

The 45 students were indicted Monday by the Guilford Grand Jury after their arrests following sit-in demonstrations at the S. H. Kress & Co. store on South Elm Street. All defendants requested jury trials in Superior Court.
