No tent open to the public shall be equipped with open flame, fire, or heat, or any flammable or combustible liquids, gas, charcoal, or any other cooking devices, and no such devices shall be used within 20 ft. of these tents while open to the public. Tents shall not be located within 20' of lot lines, buildings, other tents, parked vehicles or internal combustion engines.
