

Good Afternoon Mary,

In response to your inquire concerning when the 2012 Audits will be available for Distribution to the City and other stakeholders, I am seeking direct information from our auditor.

The former City Manager, Ms. Roth-Turner, granted a request for an extension in December and all efforts are geared to a reasonable delivery. The consolidation of five legal entities is a very difficult and time consuming process. So, at this point, all of the field work has been completed and the audits are in the drafting phase with the related notes.

Further, due to a significant number of end of year governmental deadlines, but other clients of the auditor, and the fact that we were pulled ahead of other, we are working with the auditor to make the information available as quickly as possible.

I will provide you with an additional update as soon as I hear back on the status.
