1. The TCI application shall be completed and notarized. This may be done in the Building Inspection Office at Development Services.
2. A separate electrical permit shall be issued per each TCI request. The electrical contractor for the job shall be the responsible party for taking out the required electrical permit.
3. TCI for service is for construction use only. Temporary lighting/outlets shall be installed according to NEC 590.
4. The roof and all outside windows and doors shall be installed and shall be capable of being locked when no one is on premises working. In a dwelling unit, the sheetrock shall be installed.
5. Applicant shall notify all trades that power is going to be turned on prior to energizing.
6. During the time that the electrician is not on the job site, the energized system shall be secured and locked.
7. During work hours, the energized electrical system shall be constantly supervised by the electrical contractor.
8. All other areas to be energized shall be completed, inspected, and approved before energizing. The AHJ (authority having jurisdiction) is the inspector.
9. AHJ may disconnect power and cancel temporary power permit if any part of new feeders or branch circuits have been energized without approval. Energizing for testing is permitted but power shall not be left on.
10. No furniture may be placed in building without stocking permission and all trades signed off on the site building permit.
11. No person shall occupy any area of the building before a Certificate of Compliance is issued. This includes setting up computers.
12. The electrical service equipment shall be complete; including all grounding and bonding requirements.
13. All feeders to sub-panels shall be installed. Exception: AHJ may give written permission not to install.
14. All overcurrent devices/panels capable of being energized shall be maintained in a locked, secured manner unless supervised by a qualified electrician while unlocked/unsecured.
15. All 125/240 volt, 15 and 20 ampere receptacles, authorized by the AHJ for construction use, shall be protected by listed Ground Fault Circuit-Interrupter (GFCI) device.
16. All line shields, interior trims, or dead front covers shall be installed on utilized panels.
17. If the general contractor removes his company from the job, whoever takes over the job shall fill out a new application within 2 business days or power shall be terminated. If the electrical contractor removes his company from the job, whoever takes over the job shall re-permit the TCI within 2 business days or power shall be terminated until in compliance.
18. This temporary cut in shall expire 90 days from date of connection. The general contractor must complete a new TCI form and the electrical contractor must obtain a 2nd TCI inspection, (re-apply)

Temporary Power Request Requirements (Temporary Cut In)

1. *The TCI application shall be completed and notarized. This may be done in the Building Inspection Office at Development Services.*
2. *A separate electrical permit shall be issued per each TCI request. The electrical contractor shall be the responsible party for taking out the required electrical permit(s)*
3. *TCI for service is for construction use only. Temporary wiring shall be installed per NEC 590.*
4. *The roof and all outside windows and doors shall be installed and shall be capable of being locked when no one is on premises working. In a dwelling unit, the sheetrock shall be installed.*
5. *Applicant shall notify all trades that power is going to be turned on prior to energizing.*
6. *When the electrician is not on the job site, the energized system shall be secured and locked.*
7. *During work hours, the energized electrical system, when not secured, shall be constantly supervised by the electrical contractor.*
8. *All areas to be energized shall be inspected, and approved by the AHJ before energizing.*
9. *AHJ may disconnect power and cancel temporary power permit if any part of new feeders or branch circuits have been energized without approval. Energizing for testing is permitted but power shall not be left on.*
10. *No furniture may be placed in building without a stocking CO and all trades signed off.*
11. *No person shall occupy any area of the building before a Certificate of Compliance is issued. Included is setting up computers.*
12. *The electrical service equipment shall be complete; including all grounding and bonding requirements.*
13. *All feeders to sub-panels shall be installed. Exception: AHJ may give written permission not to install.*
14. *All overcurrent devices/panels capable of being energized shall be maintained in a locked, secured manner unless supervised by a qualified electrician while unlocked/unsecured.*
15. *All 125/240 volt, 15 and 20 ampere receptacles, authorized by the AHJ for construction use, shall be protected by listed Ground Fault Circuit-Interrupter (GFCI) devices.*
16. *All line shields, interior trims, or dead front covers shall be installed on utilized panels.*
17. *If the general contractor removes his company from the job, whoever takes over the job shall fill out a new application within 2 business days or power shall be terminated. If the electrical contractor removes his company from the job, whoever takes over the job shall re-permit the TCI within 2 business days or power shall be terminated until in compliance.*
18. *This temporary cut in shall expire 90 days from date of connection. The general contractor and electrical contractor must re-apply for connection to continue. The general contractor must complete a new TCI form and the electrical contractor must obtain a 2nd TCI inspection.*
