The Solid Waste Management Commission met on Tuesday, April 26, 2016 at 3:00 p.m. in the Executive Boardroom of the Marriott Downtown Greensboro (site of the NC SWANA Convention). Council liaison Marikay Abuzaiter and Mary McClellan with ReCommunity attended the meeting.

Mark Taylor welcomed everyone to the meeting and invited them to attend a session or view the exhibits at the NC SWANA Conference.

Council member Abuzaiter stated that she had been in touch with Brenton Boyce, the newest Commission member for District 3. Nancy Lindemeyer will contact Mr. Boyce to schedule an orientation session.

**Approval of minutes of March 22, 2016 meeting**

The minutes were approved by acclamation.

**Old Business**

**a. Staff Updates**

Chris Marriott stated that the Solid Waste Hauling RFP has been posted and responses are due May 6. The Solid Waste Disposal RFP will be posted in early May. Staff is also working on an extension of the Household Hazardous Waste RFP. The Landfill Maintenance Services RFP should be posted by the end of next week.

Chris Marriott noted that the Cone Boulevard (now renamed Ralph C. Johnson Lane) Extension Project waste removal has begun and no asbestos has been found so far. He said there was no update on the White Street Landfill Gas to Energy Project.

Mark Taylor asked whether the Commission members would have an opportunity to review the Solid Waste Disposal RFP. It was agreed that Nancy will send the link to the RFP to the Commission members once it's on the City's website.

Mark Taylor stated that construction will begin soon on the Randolph County landfill.

**b. 2016 Work Plan Implementation Strategy**

Mark Taylor asked for input on the Commission's 2016 Work Plan Implementation Strategy. In response to a question about possible uses for available sites at the White Street Landfill, he stated that Bob Davis had previously suggested using a consultant to prepare options for the Commission's review. Mary Louise Smith suggested the Commission look at other landfills and see how they have used landfill property. After discussion regarding the cost of hiring a consultant, and the time involved for the Commission to do the research, Kay Brandon asked Uzo if this was a project his students could work on. Uzo said it was. It was agreed that Mark would provide an outline of the structure of the desired study to Uzo.

**Adjournment**

There being no further business before the Commission, the meeting adjourned at 3:32 p.m. The next scheduled Commission meeting is Tuesday, May 24, 2016 at 3 p.m.
