#### Why participate in this contest?

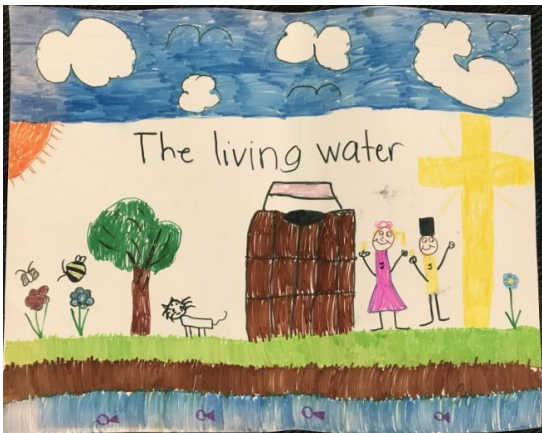
Students have the opportunity to create artwork that demonstrates the importance of water conservation while showcasing their artistic ability.

# 2017-2018 Poster Contest Guidelines

## Grades 1 - 2

Theme: Saving Water is Always in Season!

### **CONTEST RULES**

- Students must work on posters INDIVIDUALLY, not as pairs or teams
- All entries must be no larger than 22"x 28" (standard poster board size)
- Entries must have a completed entry form permanently attached to the back of the poster (No paperclips)
- Students must use crayons, markers, pens, etc. (may not use photographs, 3-D artwork, computer generated images, magazine and newspaper clippings, or glitter. Scrapbook material is not allowed.)
- Posters must be the original work of the student and depict the student's own idea(s) (Be aware of copyright protection)
- The poster must be based on the theme "Saving Water is Always in Season!"

### **JUDGING GUIDELINES**

Message (50 points): Is the message related to water conservation? Is it clearly conveyed?

Creativity (25 points): Was the message conveyed creatively?

Overall Presentation (25 points): Is the poster neat? Is the time and effort evident in the final product?

*Winning entries will be submitted to a statewide poster contest. Winners will be recognized at a regularly scheduled City Council or County Commissioners Meeting.*

### **ENTRY SUBMISSION**

Each student can only submit one poster

### **DEADLINE**

Entries should be delivered to Agricultural Center Room 108 at 3309 Burlington Road, Greensboro NC 27405 by 5pm on February 2, 2018. Late entries will not be accepted.

Submission of the posters grants permission for display. Entries will only be judged if they abide by the official contest rules. Final judging will take place by a panel of officials from the Guilford County Soil and Water Conservation District and the City of Greensboro Water Resources Department. Posters will not be returned.
