It has always been the goal of the City of Greensboro to provide citizens input in the governmental process. For that reason, most board and commissions, including Greensboro Transit Agency, are created by the Greensboro City Council pursuant to laws passed by the North Carolina General Assembly. The Greensboro Transit Agency performs an important role in the formulation of the policies and regulations for the public transportation division of the City of Greensboro, which staff implements and administers, thus bringing the views of the community to a special activity of City government. The duty of the Greensboro Transit Agency is to provide for a safe, adequate and convenient public transportation system for the City of Greensboro through the operation of a management company, currently Transdev Transportation.

The Greensboro Transit Advisory Commission (GTAC) is composed of nine (9) members appointed by the Greensboro City Council. Members serve for a term of three (3) years and continue to serve until their successors are appointed. All members must be bona fide adults maintaining a permanent residence within Greensboro's corporate city limits.

The Greensboro Transit Advisory Commission (GTAC) elects the Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson and Secretary from among its members. Additionally, there is a Greensboro City Councilperson who serves as a Transportation Liaison as a representative of the Greensboro Transit Advisory Commission on City of Greensboro City Council.
