Tuesday collection is on Wed., September 9

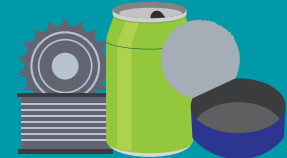
- NOVEMBER 11 - VETERAN'S DAY**
