

### TREES TO PLANT NEAR OR UNDER POWER LINES

The following plants are selections for planting under power distribution lines (along city streets and drops to buildings). These trees are small and generally do not grow taller than 15-20 feet in height. If taller varieties are available we do not recommend their use. This list is not conclusive.
