- **Mobility 2040 Advisory Committee**

The MPO and GTA are seeking input from you as we form a **Stakeholder Advisory Committee** for the Long-Range Transit Plan (Mobility GSO 2045). This committee would ideally consist of recognized leaders representing a wide diversity of positions and interests (Universities/Guilford County Schools officials, non-profits/faith houses, major employers, Chamber of Commerce reps, developers, transit riders, leaders from traditionally underserved populations, etc.).

Over the course of the study, the project team will engage with this group of key community leaders in up to three half-day workshops, one held during each round of engagement and through regular email communications. The first workshop will be in mid-summer. We appreciate your timely **nominations by May 5**.

I wanted to let you know that we had a client pass away yesterday while staying at the Regency. Many of you may be aware of our homeless resident who had been sleeping on the street outside of Urban Coffee. He is the one that had an ostomy bag and could not care for himself. Because of the extension to the Regency program, the City and the IRC were able to make sure that he was able to die with Dignity, with a warm place to sleep, a restroom, 3 meals a day, with access to medical care and case management.
